



CPC O. 47 R. 1- Postulates that such 'new and important matter or evidence', despite exercise of due diligence by the party, could not be produced at the time of passing of the order – In effect, such 'new or important matter or evidence' must have been in existence even at the time of disposal of the case but it could not be produced for bonafide reasons – The said expression would not take within its ambit an order which was passed after the disposal of the case with the sole intention of invalidating the basis of such disposed.
