

CPC, 1908, O. 6 R. 2 – Procedural law – Provisions relating to pleadings – Object of – Procedural law – Is intended to facilitate and not to obstruct the course of substantive justice – Provisions relating to pleadings in civil cases are meant to give to each side intimation of the case of the other so that it may be met, to enable courts to determine what is really at issue between parties, and to prevent deviations from the course which litigation on particular causes of action must take.
