Inherent [jurisdiction](#) of the Court to make orders *ex debito justitiae* is undoubtedly affirmed by Section 151 [cpc](#), but that jurisdiction cannot be exercised so as to nullify the provisions of the Code. Where the Code deals expressly with a particular matter, the provision should normally be regarded as exhaustive.
