

Inherent jurisdiction of the Court to make orders ex debito justitiae is undoubtedly affirmed by Section 151 [CPC](#), but that jurisdiction cannot be exercised so as to nullify the provisions of the Code. Where the Code deals expressly with a particular matter, the provision should normally be regarded as exhaustive.
