Civil Procedure Code, 1908 (V of 1908) Order 47 – <u>limitation</u> Act, 1963 (36 of 1963) Section 9 – Once time has begun to run, no subsequent disability or inability to institute a suit or make an application stops it – Therefore, the application of appellant that period spent by him in prosecuting application for <u>review</u> i.e. from 13.12.2017 to 29.5.2019 be deducted for the period of calculating limitation should be deducted is not acceptable – Therefore, the appeal filed was clearly time barred.
