Criminal Procedure Code, 1973, S. 227 - Destruction of <a href="evidence">evidence</a> - Allegation not substantiated by any material or oral/documentary evidence in the charge-sheet - No other witnesses stated anything about the appellant visiting the house of the deceased either before or after the alleged destruction of evidence has taken place, except the complainant, who even in the <a href="fir">fir</a> did not make any statement against the appellant, but later made a bald statement of her strong suspicion in her statement under Section 161 Cr.P.C. - Discharged from the charge under Section 201, IPC.
