- 1. Charge: Challenge to framing of charge, principles laid down
- 2. <u>Dismissal of an earlier S. 482 petition does not bar filing of subsequent petition.</u>
- 3. Inherent power of a High Court to stay a trial
- 4. Interlocutory order High Court may exercise its inherent powers under S. 482 to set aside an interlocutory order, notwithstanding the bar under S. 397(2)
- 5. Materials relied upon by the accused which are in the nature of public documents can be looked into
- 6. Quashing
 - 1. If the allegations set out in the complaint do not constitute the offence of which cognizance has been taken
- 7. Stay: Where stay is granted it must be decided on a day to day basis
