evidence Act, S. 138 - Cross-examination of witness by defendant - No person who is arrayed as a party can ever be denied the right to tender his evidence - The truth or otherwise of the evidence could only be tested in the <u>cross examination</u> and a party-defendant cannot be thrown out at the threshold from offering the evidence which he proposes to tender before the Courts.
