

Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 - S.13-B, S.13-B(2) - Though settlement agreement has been arrived at between the parties for seeking dissolution of their marriage by a decree of divorce by mutual consent nevertheless, the parties have been at loggerheads - Parties are living separately and there is no possibility of the parties reconciling their disputes and co-habiting together - Stipulation of six months' period indicated in Sub-section (2) of Section 13-B of the Act dispensed with . *Amardeep Singh Versus Harveen Kaur - 2017 PLRonline 0009*, relied.
