

Limitation Act, 1963 (36 of 1963) Section 9 – Clearly provides that where once time has begun to run, no subsequent disability or inability to institute a suit or make an application stops it – Therefore, the application of appellant that period spent by him in prosecuting application for review deducted for the period of calculating limitation should be deducted is not acceptable.
