

MVA S. 166 – If a Tribunal constituted under the Motor Vehicles Act, while deciding a petition under S. 166 of the Act, comes to the conclusion that the petition is not maintainable under the provisions of Section 166, then it can not convert itself into a Commissioner under the Employee's Compensation Act and thereafter, decide the claim petition accordingly. 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Driver / Employee of <u>owner</u> died while trying to extinguish fire in the tanker – Tribunal returned the <u>findings</u> that the <u>accident</u>, in which deceased lost his life, was not on account of negligence of the owner of the vehicle – Tribunal however granted compensation to the claimants by applying the provisions of the Employee's Compensation Act,1923 – It could not confer upon itself the <u>jurisdiction</u> of Commissioner under the Employee's Compensation Act – Award – Set aside.
