



MVA S. 166 - If a Tribunal constituted under the Motor Vehicles Act, while deciding a petition under S. 166 of the Act, comes to the conclusion that the petition is not maintainable under the provisions of Section 166, then it can not convert itself into a Commissioner under the Employee's Compensation Act and thereafter, decide the claim petition accordingly. 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Driver / Employee of [owner](#) died while trying to extinguish fire in the tanker - Tribunal returned the [findings](#) that the [accident](#), in which deceased lost his life, was not on account of negligence of the owner of the vehicle - Tribunal however granted compensation to the claimants by applying the provisions of the Employee's Compensation Act, 1923 - It could not confer upon itself the [jurisdiction](#) of Commissioner under the Employee's Compensation Act - Award - Set aside.
