

Privacy - Voice Recording - Evidence - Matrimonial disputes - In a private matter between couples the Court should not permit dirty linen to be washed openly in Court in the name of evidence - That is not the business of the Court - Such requests should normally be discouraged especially when the plea is not taken at the outset unless compelling reasons are found by court and the interest of justice so demands - It is also not the case that the conversation was recorded after closing of evidence - The alleged conversation was admittedly recorded prior to the divorce petition filed by the husband
