

Punjab Courts Act, Section 41 - Civil Procedure Code, 1976 S. 100 - Insofar as the State of Punjab is concerned, a second appeal does not require formulation of a substantial question of law since the Punjab Act would be applicable for the State - Section 100 of the Code would not hold the field having supervening effect - Civil Procedure Code (Amendment) Act, 1976, Section 97 - Constitution of India, Article 372(1).
