Punjab Police Rules, 1934, Rule 12.21 - Probation - Rule 12.21 is specifically meant to deal with the work or [conduct](#) of the Constables who are on probation - Appellant's contention that he has been discharged from [service](#) on account of specific misconduct but no inquiry was held, is wholly misconceived and misdirected - Opinion has been formed not with reference to a singular act of appellant's running away with a married woman (he himself is a married person) but also on account of his wilful absence from duty - [discharge](#) order is not stigmatic - No interference with the order under appeal is called for.
