



[SC] Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, S. 13(1)(ia) and (ib) - Divorce - Cruelty and desertion -- Intention on the part of the respondent to resume cohabitation is not established - An inference can be drawn that there was animus deserendi on the part of the wife - Has not pleaded and established any reasonable cause for remaining away from her matrimonial home.
