



[SC] IPC S. 420 - - In the absence of any allegation of dishonest inducement it cannot be said that offence under Section 420 has been committed.

Indian Penal Code, 1860 (XLV of 1860), S. 420 - Dishonest inducement - To make out a case against a person for the offence under Section 420 of IPC, there must be a dishonest inducement to deceive a person to deliver any property to any other person - In the present case, there is no allegation at all against accused of any inducement by her to deceive and to deliver the gold jewellery - The allegations of dishonest inducement and cheating are against her husband - In the absence of any allegation of dishonest inducement it cannot be said that she has committed any offence under Section 420 of IPC.
