- Ad hoc appointments
  - Ad- hoc employee is entitled to pensionary benefits
  - Ad hoc employee An ad hoc employee cannot be replaced by another ad hoc employee

  - Diploma through distance education cannot be equated with Diploma given through regular class room studies

  - No work No pay Exception

  - Mode of appointment through 'regularization' was a clear violation of the Constitutional scheme and was illegal

  - There can not be 100% reservation
  - Vacancy of seat in one reserved category and transfer to another

  - Out sourcing policy service provider is not an agency of the State
- Service of orders on a government servant
- Subsistence allowance
- Transfer
  - Policy of not to be transferred just prior to their retirement Not binding

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
