

Specific Relief Act 1963, S. 16 – ‘readiness’ – Burden of proof – First appellate court shifted the burden on the seller to prove that the plaintiff-buyer was incapable of paying the balance consideration – It is an established principle of law that the plaintiff-buyer must prove that he is ready and willing to perform the [contract](#) – The burden lies on the plaintiff-buyer.
