Specific Relief Act, S. 41(h) – Rights and liabilities of the co-sharers in the joint land – Plaintiff filed suit for grant of permanent <u>injunction</u> on the averments that the plaintiff and defendants are co-sharers in the suit land who in order to grab valuable portion of the joint land, also want to alienate specific portion to which, they have no right – If an efficacious remedy is available then no injunction can be granted – Suit for injunction is not maintainable where the plaintiff has equally efficacious remedy available and further remedy for getting share in joint property is <u>partition</u> and not injunction. *Ram Chander v. Bhim Singh*, (2008-3)151 PLR 747 (FB), *Kishan Singh v. Sucha Singh*, (2008-2)150 PLR 707, relied.
