

[SC] Suit for Injunction - Co-sharer - Possession of one co-sharer is possession of all co-sharers, it cannot be adverse to them, unless there is a denial of their right to their knowledge by the person in possession, and exclusion and ouster following thereon for the statutory period - Appellants (defendant Nos.1 and 2 being the purchasers of the suit property from one of the co-sharers stepped into the shoes of their vendor (co-sharer) and, therefore, had a right to defend their title and possession against the other co-sharer - Plaintiffs had no case to claim injunction against defendant Nos.1 and 2 in relation to the suit property
